Refurbishment

After many meetings and village consultation we have scaled down our ambitions for the refurbishment. We are going to adopt some plans which extend the cage area, improve storage, and allow a rear exit onto the field. We will also seek funding for repairs/replacement of the roof, drainage system and electrics.

We plan to seek a more environmental heating system, investigate solar panels, improve insulation as well as replacing the kitchen and installing an up-to-date audio-visual system.

We have discussed this with the Parish Council and let the trustees know what we are hoping to achieve. We will be taking advice from **acre** and looking at funding from grants and the Houghton Community Benefit Fund.

The new environment group in the village are giving input and also helping with finding funding for the "green" elements. Once we get a project manager we should be off the ground. It's been a long process.

The Welcome pack is still being distributed as we hear of new residents.

Finally, many thanks to Nick Harding and Graham Inskip for running the Village Draw and moving both sales and prizes on-line when we were in lockdown.
